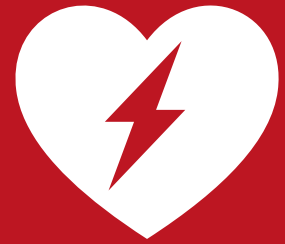
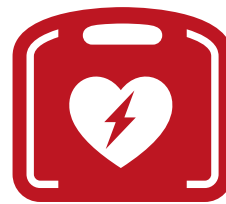


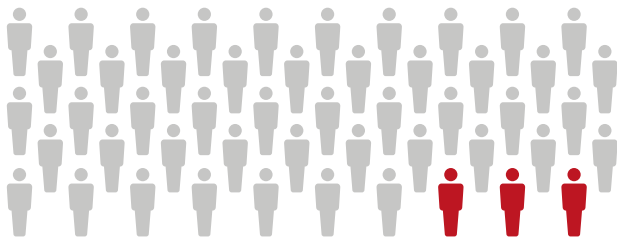
Why should you install a workplace defibrillator?



Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) is one of the leading causes of death in the UK, leading to around 100K deaths every year.



Defibrillation and CPR are key to survival rates of cardiac arrests.



Less than 6% can survive without early defibrillation.



Without defibrillation, for each minute that passes, the survival rate reduces by 7-10%.

Defibrillation within 3-5 minutes of a cardiac arrest, increases survival rates significantly from 6% to 74%.



The average ambulance response time for life-threatening 999 calls is approximately 7 minutes. Defibrillation and CPR can be given during the wait time.
